Green tips

Do your part to help save energy and water. Less money spent on utilities means more money for building maintenance. Every little bit helps, try these tips:

- Turn off unnecessary lights during daytime and when you leave.
- Do not leave the water running while brushing your teeth, shaving or washing hands.
- Use cold water when doing your laundry.
- Take shorter showers.
- Use a drying rack (or a clothesline) to dry clothes on your deck or in the back yard instead of using the dryer.
- Keep windows closed in winter. If you are too warm during winter, when possible, turn down the thermostat or speak to the Maintenance Department.
- Do not use your oven to warm up in winter if it is too cold. It is unsafe. Talk to our Maintenance Department so we can find the problem and fix it.
- Do not leave the fridge door open, and keep at ideal temperature; your fridge should be between 2 and 3 degrees Celsius, freezer between -16 and -18 degrees Celsius.
- Tell our office about leaking taps and windows or doors that do not close properly.
