### **EMERGENCIES:**

#### **PLUMBING**

- Flooding in basement
- Hot water tank leaking
- Sump pump failure
- Frozen water pipes
- Sewer backup from floor drain in basement or toilet
- No running water/no hot water

#### **HEATING**

- No heat (*months between Sept – May*)
- Gas leak / odour of gas – call 911

#### **ELECTRIC**

- No electricity throughout unit (*check for location outages first*)
- Sparking outlets / receptacles

#### **STRUCTURAL**

- Major roof leaks (*where ceiling could collapse*)
- Broken window glass – call Police if applicable to mischief, break-in attempt, etc. and obtain an occurrence number.
- Broken exterior door and/or Locks – call Police if applicable to suspected break-in attempt and obtain an occurrence number.
- FIRE – get everyone out and call 911
- Locked out – ONLY the primary leaseholder(s) are permitted to call; this is a service which will be charged back, and tenants are responsible for paying.

**EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2023 – TENANT HOUSEHOLDS WILL BE CHARGED FOR AFTER-HOURS\* CALLS DEEMED TO BE NON-EMERGENCY AT A RATE OF \$75.00 PER HOUR, PER CALL.**
